## Leader's Report.

- 1. **Boundary Review** for some reason, the announcements from the Boundary Commission on the rewarding for both Mid Suffolk and Babergh has been delayed. The arrangements should be announced on the 20<sup>th</sup> February.
- 2. **Strategic property purchase in Stowmarket** following approval at Cabinet, I am pleased to confirm that a formal offer has been made to purchase the vacant National Westminster Bank in Stowmarket. I hope to be able to confirm acceptance of the offer during the meeting.
- 3. **ComRes consultation** this consultation ended on 5<sup>th</sup> February. The results are being collated, and I shall be providing an update during the meeting.
- 4. **Locality Grants** I am pleased to say that the vast majority of the locality budget has now been fully committed. A report will be published shortly on where and who the monies have been allocated.
- 5. **General Data Protection Regulations** these new regulations come into force on 25<sup>th</sup> May 2018. Under the regulations, the Council must become compliant and that means making changes to how we as Members control, process, manage and store personal data. A series of workshops have been arranged for Members, commencing early March. I have asked in the meantime, if this topic could be the subject of a Member Briefing.
