White Horse Public House, Station Road, Finningham, Stowmarket IP14 4TL

We refer to the above referenced license application in process under the Licensing Act 2003 and wish to formally make a representation to object to the approval of the variation to the license.

Our property is situated on Westhorpe Road, on land to the rear of the White Horse Public House and whilst a functioning public house is a welcome part of any village community; it is our position that the noise from plays, films, dance and anything of a similar description to music and dance, as detailed in the application will be an unwelcome addition and will be unacceptable to us and to neighbouring properties.

Such events, particularly when hosted externally within the grounds of the public house, will serve to be a public nuisance at the very least, with objectionable sound travelling to our property (and neighbouring properties) which, from past experience of such events has proven to be both upsetting and unwanted, particularly when such events are hosted over the course of an evening and late into the night. The noise pollution from these events is particularly exacerbated in Summer months, when doors and windows are open for ventilation.

We have pets at our home, as do most of our neighbours, for whom events such as the ones detailed in this application will be extremely distressing. We have no objection to events being hosted within the public house itself, within reason, but strongly object to external events within the gardens and grounds of the public house and any variation to a license, which will allow for such events to be hosted in this manner.
