## **MCA/20/03 WOOLPIT NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN**

It was RESOLVED:-

- 1.1 That Woolpit Parish Council be requested to make the necessary modifications to their Neighbourhood Plan in accordance with the Examiner's recommendations.
- 1.2 **That, subject to satisfactory completion of the above (to be agreed by the Corporate Manager for Strategic Planning), this Neighbourhood Plan be advanced to a local referendum covering the parish of Woolpit.**

**Reason for Decision:** To enable the Council to meet its statutory obligations under Section 17A of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended) and to allow the Woolpit Neighbourhood Plan to proceed to a local referendum.

### **Alternative Options Considered and Rejected:**

- 1.1 **A Local Planning Authority may propose to make a decision on a recommendation that differs from that set out by the Examiner. If so, it must give its reason why and undertake further consultation before issuing a final decision. As appropriate, this may require the matter to be re-examined. For the reasons set out in section 4 below this option has been discarded.**
- 1.2 **The recommended option as set out below is that Mid Suffolk agree that, subject to modification, the Woolpit Neighbourhood Plan proceed to a local referendum.**
