

## **Addendum to Mid Suffolk Cabinet report – ‘Draft revised National Planning Policy Framework’ consultation proposals – 8<sup>th</sup> May 2018**

Following further consideration of others in respect of the draft revised National Planning Policy Framework consultation proposals, please note the following amendments to strengthen and improve the clarity of the proposed response.

Paragraph 1.3 – amended to state ‘seek agreement on the Babergh and Mid Suffolk District Councils response to the consultation’ rather than ‘seek agreement on the Councils’ response to the consultation’.

Paragraph 11.16 – add clarity to how planning can promote social interaction and healthy lifestyles.

Paragraph 11.19 – add clarity to the focus of the draft revised National Planning Policy Framework on avoiding building homes at low densities in areas of high demand, and pursuing higher-density housing in accessible locations, well served by public transport.
