A proposal in 2015 to establish several new short term stopping sites in Suffolk elicited a very high degree of public concern. Any site intended to host temporary Traveller or Touring caravans I believe should be considered in public if that has been requested, as it has, so that an opportunity to comment is provided and appropriate controls are agreed if it is approved.
