With reference to the above application, I would like to register my objection. This is on the grounds that when the above location held an outdoor "music Festival" (Sunday 7th October 2012), the level of noise created was such that my wife's delicate hearing was affected and our pet cat was severely stressed. Due to our close proximity to the location, the "music" sent reverberations through the ground and was making the house vibrate, so much so, that the crockery in the kitchen cupboard was rattling. This cannot be good for the structure. Even if this event was licensed, this type of event was totally inappropriate and it was obvious that any recommended sound levels were not monitored or adhered to.

Another reason for my objection is the issue of the random abandonment of vehicles in the locality by people when attending such events. These vehicles congest already choked side roads causing, possibly, the obstruction of required emergency services and scheduled buses.
