This variation application seeks to extend the start time and terminal hour for licensable activities and opening hours as well as an additional hour later for certain notable days. We have carefully considered the impact of the proposed variation and the operation of the premises in accordance with the Council's licensing policy.

Pre consultation has taken place with the Police Licensing Officer and Environmental Health Officer prior to submission. A number of conditions have been highlighted as being outdated and obsolete and therefore those have been removed and a number of revised conditions have been added.

The applicant believes the application will promote the licensing objectives in accordance with the use of company policies and procedures and the additional measures proposed in the new operating schedule, as well as the company's extensive staff training on licensing obligations.

Additionally, with regard to the hours sought and additional hour for certain notable days, the premises has operated with a number of temporary event notices to later hours without issue and which have not had a negative impact on the licensing objectives.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- 1. Where Pubwatch exists covering the area of which the premises is situated then the DPS or other nominated employee shall participate in Pubwatch.
- Where the premises are open for the sale of alcohol after 1am on Fridays and Saturdays
 the premises shall operate with a minimum of two door supervisors from 21.00hrs on
 Fridays and Saturdays. At all other times, the requirement for door staff shall be
 determined by management risk assessment.
- 3. The premises shall maintain a written drugs policy, which shall be made available to the Police or an authorised officer of the Council upon request.
- 4. An incident log book (which may be electronic) shall be kept on the premises and made available on request to an authorised officer of the Council or Police which will record the following:
 - a. Any incidents of disorder
 - b. Any seizures of drugs or offensive weapons
 - c. Any ejections of patrons
- 5. The premises shall maintain a written dispersal policy, which shall be made available to the Police or an authorised officer of the Council upon request.

c) Public safety

We understand our obligations under existing legislation and take our responsibilities seriously.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

 Reasonable steps will be taken to recognise the rights of local residents and notices will be displayed at the premises exits requesting customers to leave quietly and reminding them that they are in a residential area.

e) The protection of children from harm

- A proof of age scheme such as Challenge 21 will be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are photographic identification cards such as a driving licence or passport.
- A log (which may be electronic) shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The log shall include the date and time of the refusal and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. A copy of the log or electronic report shall be made available upon reasonable request.
- 3. All bar staff to receive appropriate training in relation to alcohol sales prior to commencing their duties. This will include the premise licence holder, underage sales policy and other relevant licensing matters. Training documents (which may be in an electronic format) shall be made available to an authorised Police Officer or Council Officer upon request.
