Subject: cafe eye licence extension

As residents of Cross Street, Eye, we wish to state that the proposed roof terrace extension for sociable alcohol consumption 7 days a week 12pm to 00.30am is not appropriate in our view, mainly for reasons of noise disturbance. The street's daytime noise levels have increased substantially in recent years and usually commence c. 7.30 am with traffic from deliveries etc as well as odours from the takeaway in Magdalen St and Cafe Eye and exhaust fumes. Warmer climate temperatures may probably require more open windows, at night and extra noise will not be welcome, neither will later night parking on the street.
