

Adoption of the Walsham le Willows Neighbourhood Plan 2023 - 2037

Dated: 24 November 2023

Walsham le Willows Parish Council and members of the local community have prepared the Walsham le Willows Neighbourhood Plan 2023 - 2037 (the 'Plan'). They have been aided by a planning consultant and have also been supported by officers at Mid Suffolk District Council.

The Decision:

Following a referendum held on Tuesday 21 November 2023, in which more than half of those who voted did so in favour of the Plan, Mid Suffolk District Council has decided to 'make' (adopt) the Walsham le Willows Neighbourhood Plan as part of its development plan framework.

Reason for the decision:

The Walsham le Willows Neighbourhood Plan has been prepared in accordance with the relevant regulations. It has been independently examined by Janet Cheesley BA (Hons) DipTP MRTPI. In her final report, published in August 2023, she concluded that subject to certain modifications the Plan meets the basic conditions and that it should proceed to a referendum.

On 22 August 2023, Mid Suffolk District Council published a statement in which they agreed to accept all of the modifications. Subject to the satisfactory completion of that task, they also agreed to take this Plan to a local referendum.

The declared referendum result was as follows:

The result means that Mid Suffolk District Council must now 'make' (adopt) the Walsham le Willows Neighbourhood Plan unless it considers that it would be in breach of any EU obligations or any of the Convention Rights (within the meaning of the Human Rights Act 1998). The District Council is satisfied that the Walsham le Willows Neighbourhood Plan is not in breach of these obligations.
